Role of near vision behaviour in the myopia progression among children (Phase 2)

Researchers at UNSW are seeking participants for a project to quantify near vision behaviour (NVB) in myopic children undergoing any form of treatment for controlling myopia progression and to establish the association between NVB and changes in the eye power, eye length and choroidal (tissue at the back of the eye) thickness.

Would the research study be a good fit for me?

The study might be a good fit for your child if your child:

- Aged 6 to 14 years old.
- Has short-sightedness greater than between -0.50 D.
- Has best corrected vision 0.1 LogMAR or better than in each eye.
