



Terminology	Definition
<b>Program compulsory core courses</b>	Courses which students must complete under their enrolled degree e.g. Bachelor of Economics/ Law 4744
<b>Economics Major</b>	Students must complete at least one major in Economics, Econometrics or Financial Economics consisting of 60UOC. The 60UOC includes 36UOC from the compulsory first and second year core courses. (ACCT1501 and ECON1401 do not count towards a major.) Students must complete at least three (3) level 3 courses (numbered 3XXX).
<b>Economics Elective</b>	Account for 12UOC (2 courses) from the School of Economics to ensure a student completes a minimum of 84UOC of Economics courses within the School of Economics.
