<b>Program compulsory core course and Introductory Business core course</b>	Students must complete ECON1401 as the compulsory core course and choose another 6UOC of Introductory Business core course.

**Economics**

	<p>Economics electives account for 12UOC (2 courses) from the School of Economics to ensure a student completes a minimum of 84UOC of Economics courses within the School of Economics (including one Introductory Business course).</p> <p>Business School electives account for 12UOC (2 courses). Students are free to use these UOC to complete courses from the Business School however they need to be mindful of the program limit on Level 1 courses (60UOC) when making their selection. GEN courses cannot count as Business School electives.</p>

**Free Electives**

These courses account for 6 courses (36 UOC) to satisfy the degree requirement of 24 courses (144 UOC). These courses may be taken from the Business School or other Faculties within UNSW. GEN coded courses cannot be counted as free electives. You may choose to use these free electives to complete a second Business major or minor, or a minor from other faculties.
