Data Management Life Cycle refers to the process for planning, creating, managing, storing, implementing, protecting, improving and disposing of all institutional data of UNSW.

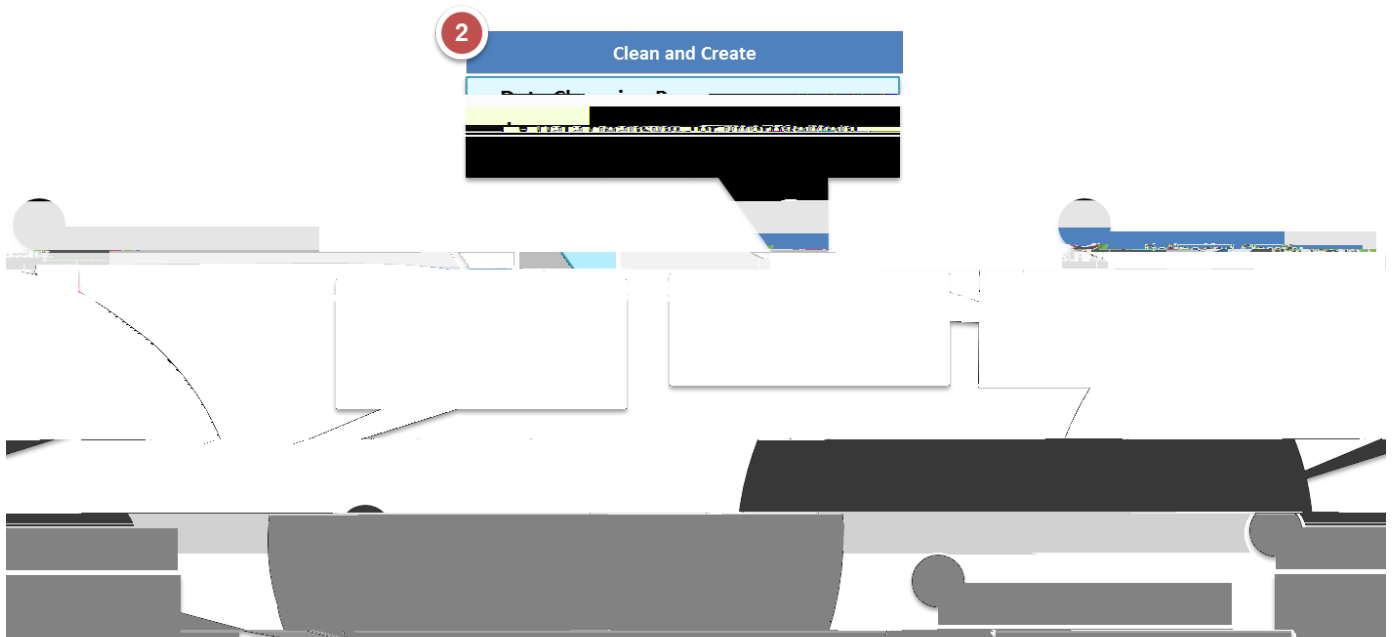
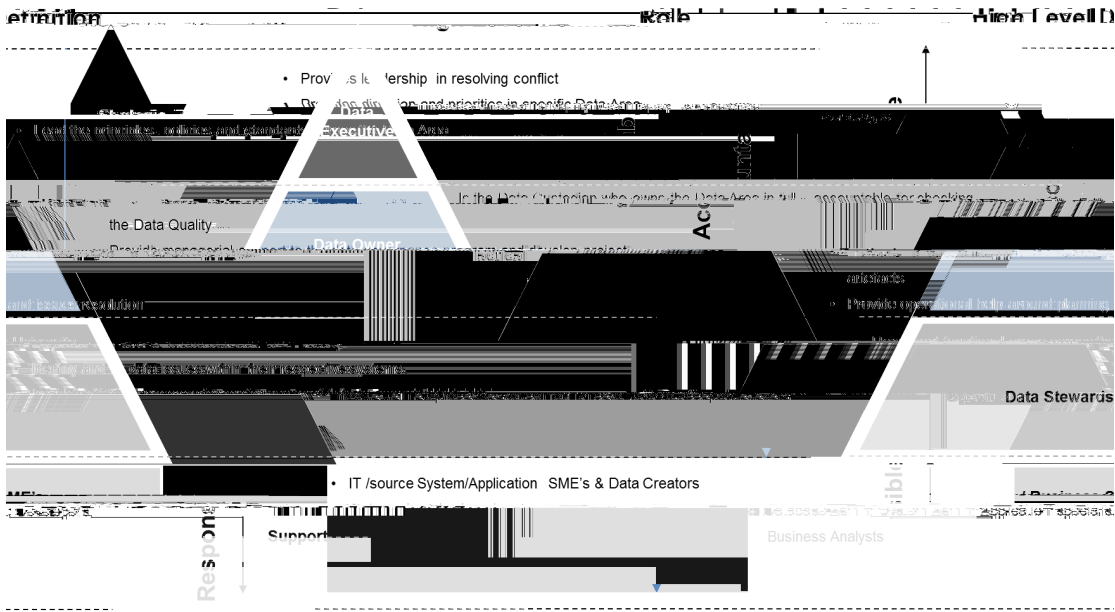


Figure 2.0 – Data Management Lifecycle
