2. Have met the minimum tertiary entrance rank (TER) requirements for UNSW Canberra

To have your entrance rank determined, you must complete this Preliminary Assessment form and submit it to sas@adfa.edu.au.

Supporting Documents

Alongside this form, submit copies of any formal academic qualifications that you may have including previous secondary, tertiary (TAFE, or University) or Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF) accredited awards.

Please note that awards received from your service are not assessable unless they have been given Civilian Accreditation.

Applicants for the Bachelor of Arts and Business will be assessed on education qualifications for admission purposes and will receive written advice on the outcome of your assessment.

Navy applicants for the Bachelor of Computing and Cyber Security, Engineering, Technology or Science will be assessed on both educational qualifications and required to complete a Maths skills check to determine levels of assumed subject knowledge. Upon completion of the Maths skills check applicants will then receive written advice on the outcome of your assessment. The outcome for Navy applicants will also be sent to Navy Education.
